#### Grace Council Meeting October 18, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 6:07 pm. Those present were: Mary Miller, Mary Houzner, Dave Clark, Kathy Besant, Kris Stauffacher, Kelly Green, and Bishop Felix Malpica. Kris led us in a devotion from the book <u>Liturgy of the Ordinary</u>.

Bishop Malpica reviewed the SAM position in general. He asked questions of Kris regarding why she became a SAM, how she thinks things are going, and her goals for Grace. She then left the room, and Bishop asked the Council to review Kris's performance. Kris returned and Bishop summarized what the Council had said.

The agenda was then reviewed and approved. The Secretary's report was reviewed. Mary H. made a motion to approve the minutes which was seconded by Mary M. Motion passed.

Committee Reports:

Worship: Will be meeting soon to choose hymns for Advent and Christmas.

Technology: Top Dog Productions in Kendall has submitted a bid with samples of his work. Kris will contact the churches in Mondovi for their evaluation. His bid is \$2000 for set up. He will train the admins on how to run the page and make changes. He will be available for questions and help. Dave made a motion, seconded by Kathy, dependent on positive feedback from Mondovi, to ask for a bid on paper, not to exceed \$2000. Motion passed.

Buildings and Grounds: The roof work on the flat roof has been finished. Our present sound system was evaluated by Peak Systems Group, Inc., Reedsburg. A paper bid has been received. There are 3 options. Mary M. will contact St Paul Lutheran and Bethany Lutheran in Mauston regarding their sound systems. Will possibly get another bid. Will discuss further at next meeting.

Education and Youth: Youth are selling raffle tickets before and after services for 3 quilts. This is a fundraiser for their trip to New Orleans for the National Youth Gathering next summer.

Old Business:

The Meals Program has paid Grace for the employment taxes for February and March. The County is on hold for accepting the bids for the Meal Program throughout the County for next year.

New Business:

Kevin and Mary H. are at the end of their 2nd terms. Will need to find new candidates. Will need to discuss the 2024 budget at next meeting. All reports for the annual meeting need to be submitted to the office by January 15th.

The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.

## A NOTE FROM KRIS: THE JOY OF THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

Advent begins this year on November 27. The new year in the church is not too far off of the calendar year, but it takes a very different path.

The church begins with Advent. This is a seen as a time to prepare. We prepare our hearts for the coming of God-with-us: Emmanuel. Then, and only then—not immediately after Halloween/Thanksgiving; we move to a time to celebrate the arrival of the newborn King, a different sort of king than the world would ever imagine.

We continue the celebration by considering how the light of the world has come to us during Epiphany.

This is followed by time of repentance and fasting: Lent. We are given 40 days and six Sundays to consider our own faults as we learn of the faults of Jesus' disciples during his time with them. Easter is the pinnacle of celebration of our year. Not only do we celebrate Jesus' resurrection but we look forward to Jesus' return to bring the kingdom of heaven to completion.

After eight more weeks of Easter we turn to Pentecost, a celebration of the coming of the Holy Spirit.

Then we begin the long period of ordinary time .We need this time as well. This is where much of life happens and God walks with us even when not much seems to be happening. The church year reflects and prepares us for our own lives and emotions. We find the way to live though times of pain, joy, gratitude, boredom, malaise, passion and hope. Let the church year guide, direct and orient your heart, season after season and year after year.
